We've always had a soft spot for Nomos' entry-point line as it balances the brand's minimalist house style with a warmth sometimes missing from other models in the collection. But now, Nomos ventures beneath the waves, turning the cute Club into a formidable diver, capable of withstanding water ingress down to 300m and based around an in-house automatic movement. The watch also features Nomos' first-ever metal bracelet, an invisible link design seemingly influenced by the look of Speidel's stretchy straps. The Club Sport is also something of a stealth diver; sure it will perform at depth, but it also makes for a very handsome everyday wearer.
